A Message from the President...

A Review of Our Infractions Policy

One of our focus points over the past year at the sportsman's club has been related to safety and security. Safety is always our number one concern.

In 2017, we updated and improved physical structures, put additional focus on educating the membership, and installed a video surveillance system.

The video surveillance system will help the board identify any rules infractions that may occur on the property. Infractions will be reviewed by the board and appropriate action will be taken on a case by case basis. Our policy has always been published in the club's range regulations manual and can be found on the website.

Thanks to our membership chair, Frank Andera, for working on the recent update.

Every ICSC member should be familiar with the infractions policy so we are including it here in the newsletter.

While on the grounds of the Isabella County Sportsman's Club, our club mandates that members exercise the maximum level of firearm safety at all times. It is only with our members help that our facility can meet member's needs while giving all members the level of service and safety that each member expects.

If, at any time, a member observes a person engaging in a careless, dangerous, or unsafe

action, the ICSC Board requires such member to take action, to document as much as possible the incident observed (i.e., use the member's cellphone to take a picture, video, etc. of the unsafe activity). The member's next step is to contact the ICSC president or chair of the range committee and submit a "Range Incident Report Form" to the individual contacted. A list of the names and phone numbers of the president and chair of the range committee is posted outside of the range office on the building inside the secure fence at the gun range.

Winter Trap League begins January 6th

The I.C.S.C. will once again be hosting a winter trap league. The 12 week league begins on Saturday, January 6, 2018. The cost is \$75 and includes the end-of-the-year banquet. You do not have to attend each week. You can shoot as often as each week or as occasionally as once a month. You just have to ensure that you are never more than two weeks behind or two weeks ahead. The trap range is open from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. each Saturday (unless the weather is absolutely dangerous). The trap pavilion is enclosed and heated for your comfort.

The trap range is open for members, guests, and the public to shoot even if you are not participating in the league. Open rounds cost \$4 for members and \$5 for non-members.

A supply of "Range Incident Report Forms" is also available at the range office.

A range officer, any member of the range committee, or any board member has the authority to confront and question any individual(s), and/or guest on the range property concerning their actions, official membership, and/or guest status. Staff from the range office, a range committee member, or an ICSC board member has the right to take immediate action, including evicting any individual(s) from the range, who has acted in an unsafe way or who has violated any of our range regulations.

The range officer/range committee member/or ICSC board member shall prepare a brief written report of the alleged safety violation by completing a Range Incident Report. The Range Incident Report is to be submitted to the ICSC president, or chair of the range committee, or to such other representative of the ICSC board as directed, as the case may be. After its' submission, the ICSC president shall review the Range Incident Report and submit the same to ICSC board members for action by the Board of Directors at the board's next regularly scheduled meeting.

Upon presentation of the Range Incident Report to the ICSC board, discussion is to take place at the next regularly scheduled Board meeting to determine what action, if any, is to be taken as the board determines. Board members have the right to issue a written warning that any future violation(s) or infraction(s) of safety rules will result in a member's suspension or termination, or to order the immediate suspension or termination of the offending member's membership and/or privileges.

If the suspended or terminated member wishes to appeal the board's decision, he/she may do so by acting within sixty (60) days of the board's original decision, by submitting a written request to appeal the board's decision and requesting an opportunity to meet in person with members of the ICSC board at the board's next regularly scheduled meeting. When considering such an appeal, the ICSC board reserves the right to modify the board's original decision or to determine not to change the board's original decision, including refusing to reinstate the suspended or terminated member's membership or privileges as the board determines. The board's decision on appeal is final as to any member's membership or privileges, as the case may be, and the board may also issue a ban on the offending member's entering the club's property, even as a guest of a member, as part of the board's decision.
